



ELIGIBILITY & INTAKE PROMGRAMMES: NAME OF THE DEGREE, ELIGIBILITY, AND INTAKE CAPACITY

The University will admit students to the postgraduate programmes leading to Masters degree from amongst the candidates who passed BA/BSc/Bcom (Three years degree Course) or equivalent examinations from a recognised University/Institute. For admission to Undergraduate programmes, the candidates should have passed 10+2 examination from a recognised University/Board.

The programme wise minimum eligibility criteria is listed at the Table below. However, relaxation in the cut-off marks and the reservation norms are given at the end of the below mentioned table.
